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THE CASTINGS AND FORGINGS INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1928.

Production from the castings and forgings industry in Canada during 1928 was valued at \$81,904,852, according to a statement issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. This output value was 18 per cent higher than the total of \$69,395,343 reported for 1927. Figures for previous years were: \$70,235,798 in 1926 and \$61,754,339 in 1925.

Production from the 327 firms reporting in this group during 1928 included heating and ventilating equipment worth \$19,993,659; pipe tubing and fittings valued at \$16,784,730; castings (sold as such) at \$10,809,921; automobile parts at \$4,996,949; forgings, \$3,784,315; machinery, \$2,199,787; chains, \$2,084,372; power and heating boilers, \$1,890,145; hardware, \$1,172,448; cold rolled and cold drawn steel, \$1,450,211; and many other lines such as steel barrels, engines, tools, enamelled ware, bolts, nuts, rivets, tanks, plumbers' goods, lawn mowers, machinery, boiler feed water heaters, hollowware, pumps, railway track equipment, etc.
