## THE WIRE AND TIRE GOODS INDUSTRY - 1948

This report presents statistics for the Wire and Wire Goods Industry which is a part of the iron and steel group and covers all establishments in Canada engaged chiefly in drawing iron and steel wire or in fabricating products from wire of iron or steel.

In 1948 the 102 factories in this industry were distributed by provinces as follows: Ontario, 60; Quebec, 25; British Columbia, 11; New Brunswick, 2; Nova Scotia, 1; Manitoba, 2; and Alberta, 1.

Factory sales in 1948 were valued at \$63,947,687 including plain and galvanized wire, barbed wire, wire fencing, wire nails, tacks, staples, screws, wire cloth, wire rope, bale ties, upholstering springs and other such commodities. In 1947 factory sales were reported at \$54,563,614 and in 1946 at \$40,133,889.

The 12 wire-drawing plants which operated in 1948 employed 3,920 workers, while the 90 establishments engaged only in the fabricating of wire goods had 3,026 workers. Sales from the wire-drawing plants amounted to \$39,284,487 and from the fabricating plants to \$24,663,200.

The average number of employees in all plants in 1948 was 6,946 of whom 4,549 worked in Ontario and 1,623 in Quebec. Payments to the 1,207 salaried employees totalled \$3,581,716 while the 5,739 wage-earners were paid \$12,573,439, a total for salaries and wages of \$16,155,155. In 1947 payments amounting to \$13,911,469 were made to 6,687 employees.
