IRON AND STEEL AND THEIR PRODUCTS

THE MISCELLANEOUS IRON AND STEEL PRODUCTS INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1930.

Production by the firms included in the miscellaneous iron and steel products industry amounted to \$12,912,310 in 1930. This value was 25 per cent under the \$17,152,169 reported for 1929 and compares with \$13,134,665 in 1927 and \$10,949,751 in 1926. Firms listed in this industry are those which cannot be readily allotted to any of the other iron and steel groups and include such plants as engage principally in the manufacture of ornamental and architectural ironwork, safes, vaults and fittings, beds and springs, railway track equipment, etc.

of the 62 firms listed in this industry, 36 were located in Ontario, 19 in Quebec, 4 in Manitoba, and 3 in British Columbia. These plants had a capital investment in Canada of \$11,738,866 and afforded employment to a monthly average of 3,102 people who received a total of \$4,415,721 in salaries and wages. Purchased materials, exclusive of fuel and electricity, cost \$5,798,796, and the value added by manufacturing processes was \$7,113,514.
