ANNUAL INDUSTRY REPORTMANUFACTURES OF THE NON-FERROUS METALS GROUPTHE MISCELLANEOUS NON-FERROUS METAL PRODUCTS INDUSTRY, 1944

The industry for which statistics are presented in this bulletin covers the operations of a miscellaneous group of concerns which cannot properly be classified to any of the other industries included in the manufactures of the non-ferrous metals group.

In 1944 there were 22 plants included in this group, 17 being located in Ontario, 4 in Quebec, and 1 in Manitoba. Production from these factories was valued at \$5,562,441; the number of employees was 862; payments for salaries and wages totalled \$1,323,647, and the cost of materials for use in manufacturing processes was \$1,770,096.

Production included gasoline lamps, lanterns, camp stoves and irons; weatherstrip; cigarette lighters and flints for lighters; railway and marine lamps and lanterns; window screens; lamp and lantern burners; name plates, metallic packing, Stellite, etc. Output of weatherstrip amounted to \$55,691 in 1944 compared with \$59,818 in 1943. Figures for the other commodities cannot be published as there was only one or two producers in each case.
