EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. Due to "Dealer to Dealer" transactions some duplication exists in the figures given in the 'Purchases or Receipts' column.
2. The data on imports and exports have been taken from the monthly "Trade of Canada" report issued by External Trade Branch, Dominion Bureau of Statistics. These figures are not confined solely to operations of scrap metal dealers whose reports comprise the major part of this tabulation.
3. The letters "n.a.p." means "not available for publication" as only one or two companies reported quantities for these items. Such quantities are included in the totals for Canada.
