> FEERUARY, 1933.


Production of 3,298 automobiles in Canada during February, a short month, showed littlo change from the 3,358 cars of the previous month but was 40 per cent below the output for February, 1932, when 5,477 cars were made. This month's figures when compared with those for January show that passenger cars registered a slight improvement to 3,025 from 2,921 while trucks declined to 273 from 437.

Of the February output 3,130 cars were made for sale in Canada, leaving a balance of only! 168 for export. The apparent consumption of cars in Canada during the month, as detormined by adding the 3,130 cars made for sale in Canada to the 99 imported, amounted to 3,229 cars. Exports for the month were reported at 277 cars.
