## \&UCOMOBILE STATISTICS FUR CANADA

ARRTL, 1933


Production of autombiles in Canada during April at 8, 255 units merked an improvenent of 24 per cent over the 6,632 cars of the provious month and of 21 per cent over the 6,810 cars produced in April of a year ago. The gain in April as compared with March favourably affected the autput of hoth passenger cars and trucks; the former advanced to 6.957 mits from 5,927 and trucks to 1, 298 from 705.

Of the April total 5,643 cars were made for sale in Caneda, leaving a balance of 2,612 intended for export. The apparent consumption of cars in Canada during the month, as determined by adding the 5,643 cars made for sale in Caneda to the 226 cars imported, amounted to 5,869 cars. For the four months ending April 30, 1933, a total of 21,543 cers were produced in Cenada, 612 cars were imported and 3,686 cars were exported.
