## AUTGMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANAIG

JUY, 1933.

Production of automobiles in Canada during July numbered 6,540 units as compared with 7,523 cars in June and 7,472 cars in July of a year ago. The deckine from the previous month was altogether accounted for by the drop in cars made for sale in Canada to 4,562 from 5,522 , wille the number made for export advanced to 1,978 from 1,801.

The apparent consumption of cars in Canada during the month, as determined by adding the 4,562 made for sale in Canada to the 181 imported, amounted to 4,743 cars. For the seven montis ending July 31, 1933, a total of 44802 cars was produced in Canada, 1,110 were imported and 10,504 exported.
