AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

NOVEMBER, 1934.

Production of automobiles in Canada during November included 1,075 cars made for sale in this country and 622 intended for export, a total of 1,697 units. In the previous month output was reported at 3,780 cars and in November of a year ago at 2,291 cars.

Of the total cars made during the month, 1,052 were passenger cars and 645 were trucks. The passenger cars included 19 open models, 6 passenger chassis and 1,027 closed models. Of the trucks, 70 had a capacity of less than one ton, 242 were from one to one and a half tons, 313 ranged from one and a half to two and a half tons, and 20 were rated at more than two and a half tons capacity.

Imports of automobiles into Canada numbered 107 in November as against 141 in the previous month. Exports were also lower at 1,929, the October figure being 3,778.

For the first eleven months of this year the cumulative output of motor vehicles in Canada totalled 114,158 cars, an improvement of 82 per cent over the 62,662 cars made in the corresponding period of 1933 and 95 per cent greater than the 58,677 cars produced in the first eleven months of 1932.
