AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

AUGUST, 1935

Production of automobiles in Canada during August included 4,933 units made for sale in this country and 4,971 for export, a total of 9,904 units. In the previous month output amounted to 11,114 units and in August of a year ago to 6,079 units.

The total for August included 7,325 passenger cars and 2,579 trucks. Of the passenger cars, 1,047 were open models, 5,554 were closed and the balance of 724 were passenger chassis. Of the trucks 466 were of 1 ton capacity, 1,743 had a capacity of from one to one and a half tons and 368 ranged from one and a half tons to less than 5 tons.

Imports of automobiles dropped to 189 in August from 288 in July. Exports declined to 3,567 from 6,598 in July.

For the eight months ending August 31, 1934, the cumulative output of motor cars in Canada numbered 103,102 units, an increase of 103 per cent over the 50,881 units made in the corresponding period of a year ago and 101 per cent over the 51,208 units reported for the first eightmonths of 1932.
