AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

SEPTEMBER. 1934.

Production of automobiles in Canada during September included 1,371 units made for sale in this country and 4,208 for export, a total of 5,579 units. In the previous month the output amounted to 9,904 units and in September of a year ago to 5,808 units.

The total for September included 4,211 passenger cars and 1,368 trucks. Of the passenger cars, 443 were open models, 2,868 were closed and the balance of 900 were passenger chassis. Of the trucks, 309 were of less than one ton capacity, 1,029 had a capacity of from one to one and one half tons, and 28 ranged from over one and one half tons to less than five tons.

Imports of automobiles dropped to 110 in September from 189 in August. Exports declined to 3,343 from 3,567 in August.

For the nine months ending September 30, 1934, the cumulative output of motor cars in Canada numbered 108,681 units, an increase of 92 per cent over the 56,689 units made in the corresponding period of last year and 103 per cent over the 53,550 units reported for the first nine months of 1932.
