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AUTOMOBILES - JANUARY, 1935.

Production of 10,607 automobiles in Canada during January marked an improvement of 288 per cent over the 2,732 cars of December and 54 per cent over the 6,904 cars made in January of a year ago. The increase over the previous month was due to the number made for sale in Canada advancing to 6,021 from 2,334 and the number made for export to 4,586 from 398.

Of the total passenger cars made during the month 60 were permanent open models, 21 were convertible cars, 6,366 were permanent closed cars and 1,822 were chassis. Of the trucks, 1,785 had a capacity of less than 2 tons, 549 rated between 2 and 5 tons capacity and 3 were rated at over 5 tons.
