### AUTOMOBILES - OCTOBER, 1935.

Production of 8,313 motor vehicles in Canada during October was the highest total reported for any October since 1929 and marked an improvement of 56 per cent over the September output of 5,323 cars and 120 per cent over the 3,780 cars made in October of a year ago. The October increase was due to the introduction of next year's models at an earlier date than in former years.

This month's output included 7,128 passenger cars and 1,185 trucks compared with 3,819 passenger cars and 1,504 trucks in September. Of the cars made for sale in Canada during the month, 4,033 were passenger cars and 694 were trucks, the balance of the cars and trucks being intended for export.

Actual exports, according to customs' records, totalled 3,931 as against 4,792 in September. Imports during the same period advanced to 180 from 164.

For the first ten months of this year production numbered 145,663 units as compared with corresponding figures for the same period of other years, as follows: 112,461 in 1934; 60,371 in 1933, and 56,473 in 1932.
