## AUTOMOBILES - FEBRUARY, 1935.

Production of automobiles in Canada at 18,114 units in February was 71 per cent over the 10,607 cars of January and 111 per cent over the 8,571 cars made in February of a year ago. The improvement over January was accounted for by the gain in the number of passenger cars to 13,885 from 8,269 and in the number of trucks to 4,229 from 2,338.

The apparent consumption of cars in Canada during February as computed by adding the imports to the number of cars made for sale in Canada amounted to 10,574 . Corresponding consumption figures for January totalled 6,285 and in February, 1934, 5,605.
