## AUTOMOBILES - $\mathrm{MARCH}_{2}$ 1935.

Production of automobiles during March totalled 21,975 units, the highest output reported for any month since May, 1930, when 24,672 cars were made. The March total was 21 per cent over February of this year and 55 per cent over March of last year.

The apparent consumption of motor cars in Canada during March as computed by adding the 587 imported cars to the 14,046 cars made for sale in Canada amounted to 14,633 units. Exports during March were reported at 9,379 cars; this was the greatest number shipped abroad since October, 1929, when 9,757 cars were sent to foreign countries.
