## AUTOMOBILES - APRIL, 1935.

Production of automobiles during April was renorted at 24,123 units, an advance of almost 10 per cent over the March total of 21,975 cars and the highest number reported for any month since May, 1930. In April of a year ago only 18,363 motor cars were made in Canada.

The April output included 17,813 cars intended for sale in Canada and 6,310 for export. Actual exports in April numbered 6,371 cars compared with 9,379 in March, and imports amounted to 520 as against 587 for last month.

The apparent consumption in Canada as determined by adding imports to the number made for the domestic market amounted to 18,333 units in April compared with 14,633 in March. In April of last year the apparent consumption totalled 13,790 cars.
