## AUTOMOBILES - JUNE, 1955.

Production of automobiles in Canada numbered 15,745 units in June, a decline of 24 per cent from the 20,702 units made in the next preceding month and 14 per cent over the 13,905 cars produced in June of a year ago.

This month's output included 12,276 passenger cars and 3,469 trucks compared with 17,030 passenger cars and 3,672 trucks in May. The number of cars made for sale in Canada during June dropped to 9,910 from 16,081 in May while the number made for export advanced to 5,835 from 4,621 .

Actual exports, according to customs' records, totalled 4,873 in June against 6,499 in May. Imports also declined to 365 from 569.

Automobile production during the first six months of this year included lll,266 motor vehicles, the corresponding half-year totals for other years being 82,084 in 1934 and 58,262 in 1933.
