AUTOMOBILES - JULY, 1935.

Production of automobiles in Canada numbered 13,069 units in July, a decline of 17 per cent from the 15,745 cars made in the previous month but an increase of 17.6 per cent over the 11,114 cars made in July of a year ago.

This month's output included 9,471 passenger cars and 3,598 trucks compared with 12,276 passenger cars and 3,469 trucks in June. The number of cars made for sale in Canada dropped to 7,147 from 9,910 in the previous month while the number intended for export advanced slightly to 5,922 from 5,835.

Actual exports, according to customs' records, totalled 5,105 in July as against 4,873 in June. Imports during this period declined to 335 from 365.

Automobile production during the first seven months of this year totalled 124,335 units compared with corresponding figures for earlier years as follows:-93,198 in 1934, 44,802 in 1933, and 47,141 in 1932.
