AUTOMOBILES - SEPTEMBER, 1935.

Production of automobiles in Canada numbered 5.323 units during September, a decline of 31 per cent from the 7,692 units reported for the previous month and 9 per cent from the 5,579 units made in September of a year ago.

This month's output included 3,819 passenger cars and 1,504 trucks compared with 5,524 passenger cars and 2,168 trucks in August. Of the cars made for sale in Canada during the month 1,109 were passenger cars and 416 were trucks, the balance of the cars and trucks being intented for export.

Actual exports, according to customs' records, totalled 4,792 as against Imports for the same period declined to 164 from 269. 6,009 in August

For the first nine months of this year automobile production numbered 137,350 units as compared with corresponding figures for the first three quarters of other years, as follows - 108,681 in 1934, 56,689 in 1933, and 53,550 in 1932.
