AUTOMOBILES - JANUARY, 1936.

Production of automobiles in Canada during January numbered 13,302 units against 13,775 cars made in December and 10,607 cars in January of a year ago. This month's output included 11,261 passenger cars and 2,041 trucks; 7,167 of the passenger cars and 1,053 trucks being intended for sale in Canada and the balance in each case for export.

Customs figures for the month show that 451 cars were imported and 6,622 exported during January as compared with imports of 264 and exports of 1,598 in January, 1935.
