MONTHLY REPORT

AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTION - NOVEMBER, 1956

Production of 10,812 automobiles in Canada during November represented an increase of 102 per cent over the 5,361 units of October and a decline of 19 per cent from the 13,496 units made in November of a year ago.

Compared with the figures of the previous month data for November showed an improvement in the output of passenger cars to 10,086 units from 4,592 units while the number of trucks declined to 726 from 769. Of the November total 7,491 cars were made for sale in Canada with a balance of 3,321 being intended for export.

Customs figures for the month showed that 1,088 cars and trucks were imported into Canada and 5,161 exported. During the first eleven months of this year 51,860 cars were exported from Canada and production during the period amounted to 141,911 units.
