MONTHLY REPORT
AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTION - September, 1936
Production of 4,655 automobiles in Canada during September showed little change from the 4,660 units reported for the previous month and compares with 5,323 units made in September, 1935

Passenger car production was recorded at 2,481 in September against 3,051 in August and commercial cars or trucks at 2,174 against 1,609. Output of passenger cars in September, 1935 numbered 3,819 and commercial cars, 1,504.

Customs' figures for September show that 478 cars and trucks were imported into Canada and that 3,514 were exported during the month. The comparative figures for a year ago amounted to 164 imports and 4,792 exports.
