MONTHLY REPORT

AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTION - NOVEMBER, 1937.

Production of automobiles in Canada numbered 6,574 units in November against 8,103 cars in the previous month and 10,812 in November, 1936.

Passenger car output during the month was reported at 13,793 units and trucks at 2,781. Of these totals, 3,142 passenger cars and 848 trucks were made for export, with the balance of 10,651 passenger cars and 1,933 trucks being intended for sale in Canada.

For the first eleven months of this year a total of 186,348 cars were produced in Canada, a gain of 31 per cent in number over the 141,911 cars reported for the corresponding period of a year ago.
