MONTHLY REPORT

AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTION - AUGUST, 1937.

Production of automobiles in Canada during August numbered 10,742 units, a decline of 40 per cent from the 17,941 units made in July, and an increase of 130 per cent over the 4,660 units reported for August, 1936.

Passenger car output during the month totalled 5,814 units and commercial vehicles numbered 4,928. Of these totals, 661 passenger cars and 2,226 trucks were for the Canadian market and 5,153 passenger cars and 2,702 trucks were intended for export.

For the first eight months of this year a total of 157,254 motor vehicles were produced in Canada, a gain of 30 per cent in number over the 121,083 units made in the corresponding period of a year ago.
