## MONTHIY REPORT

## AUTOMUBILE PROTUCTION - SEPMNGER, 1937.

Production of automobiles in Canada during September numbered 4,417 units as against the 10,742 units made in August and 4,655 units made in September, 1936.

Passenger car output during the month numbered l,926 units and commercial vehicles totalled 2,491. of these totals, 541 passenger cars and 854 trucks were made for the Canadian market with the balance of 1,385 passenger cars and 1,637 trucks being intended for export.

For the first nine months of this year, 161,671 motor vehicles were produced in Canada, a gain of 29 per cent in number over the 125,738 units made in the corresponding period of a year ago.
