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MONTHLY REPORT

AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTION - DECEMBER, 1938.

Production of 18,670 motor vehicles in Canada during December was, with the exception of the total for April, the highest monthly output reported this year. It exceeded the 17,992 cars of the previous month by 4 per cent but was 12 per cent less than the 21,115 cars made in December, 1937.

REVIEW FOR 1938.

During 1938 a total of 166,142 automobiles were produced in Canada, a decline of 20 per cent from the 207,463 reported for 1937. Compared with other years this total showed an increase over the figures for 1936, a decline from 1935 and an increase over 1934, 1933, 1932, 1931 and 1930. Included in the 1938 figures were 125,081 passenger cars and 41,061 trucks, a decline of 18 and 25 per cent respectively, from the corresponding figures of a year ago. The number of motor vehicles made for sale in Canada dropped 22 per cent to 109,173, while the number intended for export dropped 16 per cent to 56,970.

Output started in January at 17,624 units, dropped to 16,066 in February, a short month, and then advanced to 16,802 in March after which the high for the year of 18,819 was reached in April. Production then declined steadily to the low of 5,774 in October but as the factories began producing new models the figures rose to 17,992 in November and closed the year at 18,670 in December.

Exports during 1938 totalled 57,909 units, a decline of 12 per cent from the 66,143 in the previous year and imports at 15,154 were 24 per cent under the 20,069 units of 1937.

A calculation to show the number of new automobiles placed on Canadian roads during a year may be made by deducting the exports from the sum of the production and imports. This figure for 1938 amounted to 123,387 vehicles, for 1937 to 161,389 and for 1936 to 116,225. By applying the net imports to these totals it follows that Canadian manufacturers supplied 87.8 per cent of the home market in 1938, 87.7 per cent in 1937 and 92.0 per cent in 1936.
