MONTHLY REPORT

AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTION - DECEMBER, 1939

In December the output of automobiles totalled 16,978 units compared with 16,756 in the previous month and 18,614 in December of a year ago. This month's total included 11,491 passenger cars and 5,487 trucks. About 83 per cent of the passenger cars, or 9,545 units, and 47 per cent of the trucks, or 2,576 units, were made for sale in Canada while the remaining 1,946 passenger cars and 2,911 trucks were intended for export.

REVIEW FOR 1939

Production of automobiles in Canada at 155,316 units in 1939 was 6.5 per cent under the 1938 output of 166,086 cars. Corresponding totals for other years were as follows: 207,463 units in 1937; 162,159 units in 1936, and 172,877 units in 1935.

In the current year, output started at 14,794 units in January, reached a peak of 17,549 in March, then fell off gradually until June, after which the seasonal decline carried output to the low of 3,475 in August. With the advent of new models in October production rose sharply to 11,296, and by December had increased to 16,978 units, the volume in this month being greater than for any corresponding period since March.

Imports of 18,269 cars into Canada during 1939 showed an increase of 21 per cent over the 15,154 in 1938, which in turn was 24 per cent under the 20,069 in 1937. Exports during 1939 numbered 58,720 cars, an increase of nearly 2 per cent over the 57,908 in 1938, but 12 per cent less than the 1937 total of 66,143 units. Shipping hazards during the final quarter of the year apparently did not seriously affect the export trade in automobiles as shipments followed the trend of last year and even showed a slight gain.

Sales of automobiles in Canada during the eleven months ending November 1939 were down 6.9 per cent in number from 1938 levels. A decline from the previous year occurred during each of the first eight months of 1939, but this was converted into an advance of 18 per cent in September, 8 per cent in October and 6 per cent in November. Every province of the Dominion showed lower sales for the eleven-month period excepting Saskatchewan where the gain was 45.5 per cent. In the Maritimes the drop was 4.9 per cent, in Quebec 7.6 per cent, in Ontario 12.2 per cent, in Manitoba 17.8 per cent, in Alberta 4.2 per cent and in British Columbia 2.3 per cent.
