## MONTHLI REPOKT

AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTION - AUGUST, 1939.

The production of 3,475 motor vehicles in Canada during August compares with an output of 9,135 in the provious month and 6,452 in August, 1938. Included in the figures for this month were 1,068 passenger cars and 2,407 trucks. Of these totals, 459 passenger cars and 1,455 trucks were made for sale in Canada with the balance of 609 passenger cars and 952 tmucks being intended for export.

For the eight months ending August 31, 1939, the cumulative production of automobiles in Canada numbered 106,365 units compared with 117,617 and 157,254 units made in the corresponding periods of 1938 and 1937, respectively.
