## AUTOMOBILE PHODUCIION - OCTOBER, 1940

Production of motor vehicles in Canada numbered 21,151 units in October compared with 15,475 in September and 11, ?97 in October, 1939. This month's total included 7,056 passenger cars and 14,095 trucks.

For the elrst ten months of this year, 87,659 passenger cars and 88,340 comaercial vehicles, a total of 175,999 units, were produced in Canada. This totel compares with 121,694 units and 129,480 units made during the corresponding periods of 1939 and 1938, respectively.
