MONTHLY REPORT

AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTION - MARCH, 1940

Production of motor vehicles in Canada totalled 16,612 units during March Compared with 18,193 in the previous month and 17,549 in March, 1939. This month's total included 12,025 passenger cars and 4,587 commercial vehicles.

For the three months ending March, the cumulative output amounted to 52,018 units, a gain of 11.5 per cent over the 46,645 units reported for the first quarter of a year ago.
