MONTHLY REPORT

AUTOMOBILE PRODUCTION - MAY, 1940

Production of 21,277 automobiles in Canada during May was the highest for any month since June, 1937 when 23,841 units were made. This month's total included 12,677 passenger cars and 8,600 trucks, of which 11,244 passenger cars and 6,058 trucks were made for sale in Canada and 1,433 passenger cars and 2,542 trucks were intended for export.

For the five months ending May 31, 1940, the cumulative production of automobiles in Canada numbered 92,982 units compared with 79,240 in the corresponding period of a year ago. Exports for the five-month period totalled 19,594 in 1940 and 28,717 in 1939.
