MONTHLY REPORTAUTOMOBILE PRODUCTION - NOVEMBER, 1941

Production of motor vehicles in Canada totalled 21,545 units during November, compared with 19,360 made in the previous month and 23,621 in November of a year ago. Included in the figures for the month under review were 7,003 passenger cars, and 14,542 trucks and army vehicles against 5,635 passenger cars and 13,725 trucks in October. Of the November totals 6,253 passenger cars and 7,069 trucks were made for sale in Canada, while 750 passenger cars and 7,473 trucks were intended for export.

For the eleven months ended November 30, 1941, the cumulative output of automobiles numbered 250,118 units, compared with 199,620 units in the corresponding period of a year ago.
