

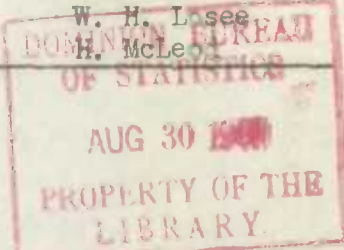

MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS - CANADA - JULY, 1947

Factory shipments of Canadian-made motor vehicles totalled 21,907 units in July of this year, compared with 21,137 units in June. For the first seven months of 1947 factory shipments amounted to 148,122 units, including 92,884 passenger cars, 54,790 trucks and 448 buses.
