Monthly Report onMOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS - CANADA - SEPTEMBER 1947

Factory shipments of Canadian-made motor vehicles totalled 24,205 units in September of this year, compared with 15,659 units in August. For the first nine months of 1947, factory shipments amounted to 187,986 units, including 118,794 passenger cars, 68,591 trucks and 601 buses.

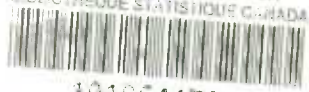
