### MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS - CANADA - FEBRUARY, 1948

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 16,382 units in February, 1948, compared with 16,715 units in the previous month and with 20,331 units in February, 1947. The shipments for the current month included 9,926 passenger cars, 6,446 trucks and 10 buses.

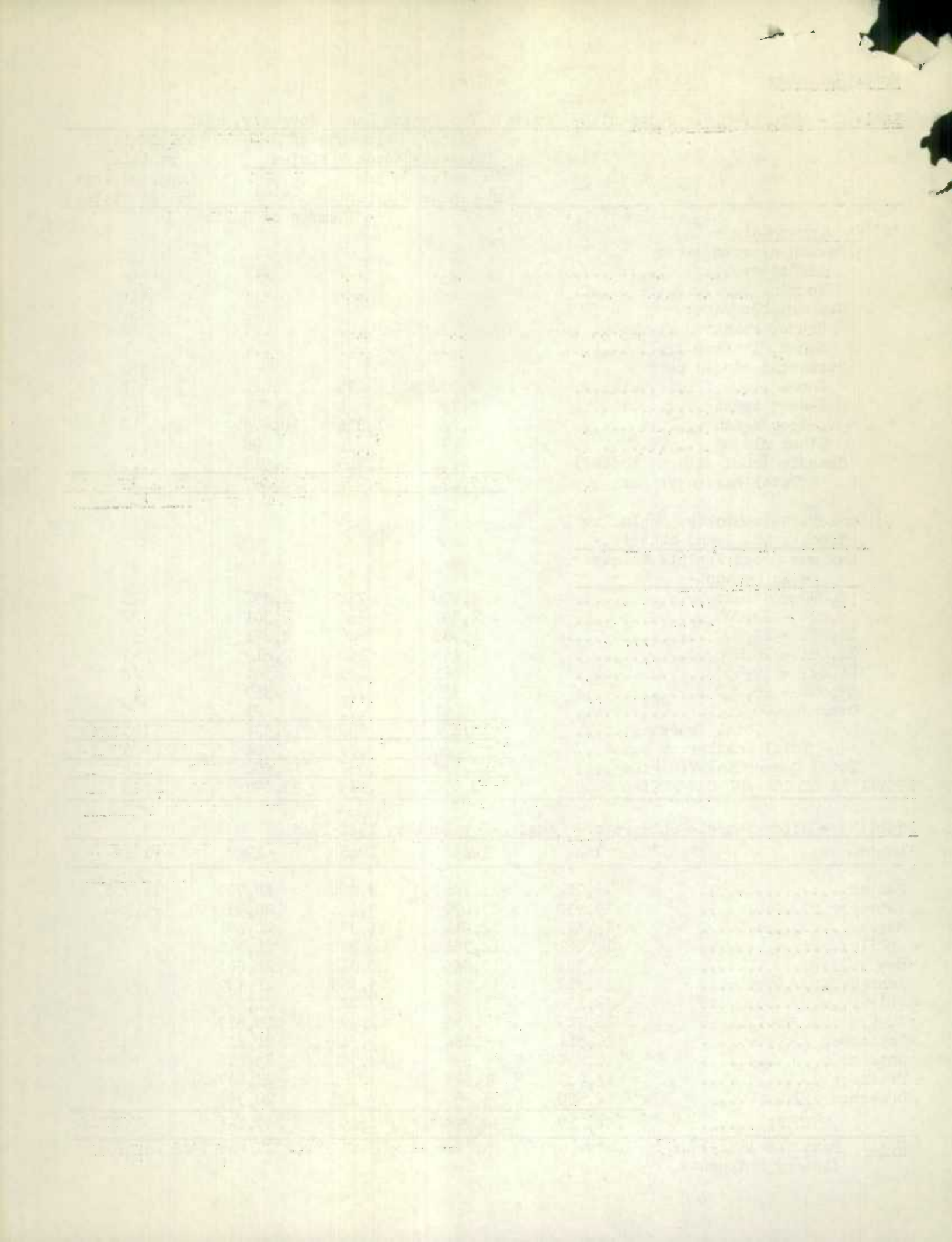
