

## Monthly Report on

## MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPIENTS - CANADA - JULY, 1948

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 15,106 units in July, 1948 compared with 23,362 units in the previous month and with 21,907 units in July, 1947. The shipments for the current month included 9,509 passenger cars, 5,535 trucks and 62 buses.
