GYFSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA, OCTOBER, 1932.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that the production of gypsum in Canada during October totalled 52,345 tons as compared with 52,130 tons in the preceding month and 82,487 tons in October, 1931. During the ten months ending October the Canadian output of gypsum amounted to 390,956 tons or 48.4 per cent below the total produced in the corresponding months of 1931.

Crude gypsum exported from Canada in October amounted to 36,807 tons valued at \$51,156 as compared with 45,740 tons worth \$59,084 exported in September. Exports of plaster of Paris reached a total of 205 tons evaluated at \$3,001; in the preceding month 57 tons at \$1,216 were exported.

Imports of plaster of Paris into Canada declined to 9 tons appraised at \$874 from the September total of 65 tons worth \$1,217. Minor tonnages of crude and ground gypsum were imported into Canada in October.
