GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1932.

Gypsum production in Canada during November amounted to 27,601 tons; in the preceding month 52,345 tons were produced and in November, 1931, the output was 51,414 tons, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Canadian producers reported a production of 418,557 tons of gypsum during the eleven months ending November as compared with 809,341 tons in the corresponding period of 1931.

Exports of crude gypsum during the month totalled 48,055 tons with a value of \$56,007; in October 36,807 tons worth \$51,156 were exported. Plaster of Paris exports in November consisted of 26 tons at \$500 shipped to Australia; in the previous month the total exports were recorded at 205 tons evaluated at \$3,001.

Imports of plaster of Paris into Canada advanced to 177 tons from the October total of 9 tons. Eighty-five per cent of the November importations were obtained from Germany and 15. per cent from the United States. Ground gypsum imports into Canada in November were made up of 40 tons from Great Britain and 3 tons from the United States.
