GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA, JULY, 1932.

A report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa shows that the production of gypsum in Canada during July amounted to 80,144 tons as compared with the preceding month's total of 70,707 tons and the July, 1931 shipments of 133,349 tons. During the seven months ending July, 217,019 tons of gypsum were produced in Canada, in the corresponding period of 1931 the production totalled 433,875 tons.

Exports of crude gypsum by Canadian producers reached a total of 44,575 tons valued at \$50,978, during June, 30,195 tons at \$36,343 were exported. Calcined plaster of Paris exportations rose to 36 tons worth \$364 from the June exports of 7 tons at \$281.

Plaster of Paris, calcined, imported into Canada in July consisted of 50 tons received from Germany and 7 tons from the United States. Imports of plaster of Paris, not calcined, were negligible in July; during the preceding month 50 tons at \$1,131 were imported into Canada.
