## GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA, AUGUST, 1932.

The Canadian production of gypsum in August was recorded at 69,462 tons according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In the preceding month 80,144 tons were produced and in August, 1931, the total was 126,515 tons. During the first eight months of 1932 the production totalled 286,481 tons or 48.9 per cent below the shipments in the corresponding period of 1931.

Crude gypsum exports advanced to 73,750 tons from the July exportations of 44,575 tons. Exports of plaster of Paris amounted to 29 tons worth \$667 as compared with 36 tons at \$364 exported in the preceding month.

Imports of plaster of Paris into Canada during August were recorded at 62 tons appraised at \$2,535. Ground gypsum importations amounted to 3 tons worth \$145, in addition, 4 tons of crude gypsum valued at \$123 were cleared through Canadian ports.
