GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1933.

The Canadian production of gypsum in November of 70,181 tons was the highest monthly total on record since July, 1932, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In October 30,059 tons were produced and in November, 1932, the production was 27,657 tons. During the eleven months ending November Canada's gypsum output totalled 363,374 tons as compared with 418,978 tons in the corresponding period of 1932.

Exports of crude gypsum from Canada in November were recorded at 17,945 tons; in the preceding month 25,737 tons were exported. Three tons of plaster of Paris were exported from Canada in November as compared with 76 tons in October.

Twelve tons of ground gypsum and 156 tons of plaster of Paris were imported into Canada in November. Germany supplied 96.2 per cent of the total plaster of Paris imports.
