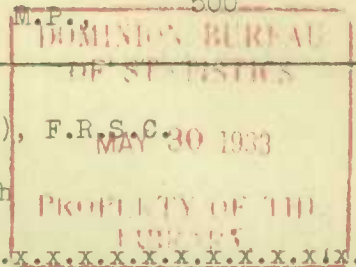

GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1933.

Gypsum production in Canada during February amounted to 2,426 tons as compared with 2,728 tons in January and 6,101 tons in February, a year ago, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

No crude gypsum was exported from Canada during February; in the preceding month 4,500 tons were exported to the United States. Approximately 7 tons of plaster of Paris were exported from Canada in February as against 85 tons in January.

Imports of plaster of Paris into Canada during February were recorded at 26 tons worth \$1,067. Three tons of crude gypsum and 1 ton of ground gypsum were also imported during the month.
