GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA, MARCH, 1933.

PROPERTY

Canada produced 4,160 tons of gypsum during March; in the preceding month 2,426 tons were produced and in March, 1932, the output was 5,862 tons, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Production during the first three months of 1933 totalled 9,314 tons as compared with 18,377 tons in the corresponding period of the previous year.

No crude gypsum has been exported from Canada during the past two months; in January, 4,500 tons were exported to the United States. Twenty-three tons of plaster of Paris were shipped from Canada in March as against 7 tons in the preceding month.

Plaster of Paris imports into Canada amounted to 23 tons valued at \$726; in February, 26 tons worth \$1,067 were received. The March imports were obtained from the United States.
