. GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA, JUNE AND JULY, 1933.

A report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa shows that the production of gypsum in Canada amounted to 50,070 tons in June and in July, 61,457 tons. In the preceding year the June output was 70,719 tons and the July, 80,273 tons. During the seven months ending July, Canadian producers reported an output of 158,482 tons as compared with a total of 216,656 tons in the corresponding months of 1932.

Exports of crude gypsum in June reached a total of 21,400 tons worth \$23,380; in July 42,851 tons at \$46,932 were exported. Plaster of Paris exportations in June amounted to 60 tons with a valuation of \$1,574 and in July totalled 86 tons worth \$1,697.

Imports of plaster of Paris into Canada in June were recorded at 91 tons appraised at \$2,728; the United States supplied 73.7 per cent of these imports. During July 50 tons worth \$1,519 were imported, of which 90 per cent came from the United States.
