

Canada produced 4,888 tons of gypsum in March, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Cttawa. During February 3,309 tons were produced and in March, a year ago, 4,160 tons. Output during the first quarter of 1934 totalled 11,500 tons or 23.5 per cent above the total for the corresponding period of 1933.

No crude gypsum was exported from Canada in Werch. Exports of plaster of Paris arounted to 32 tons as compared with 57 tons in February.

Imports of ground gypsum into Canada in March consisted of 8 tons valued at $\$ 188$; in the preceding month 3 tons worth $\$ 146$ were imported. Receipts of plaster of Paris in March advanced to 56 tons appraised at $\$ 2,176$ from the February total of 43 tons at $\$ 1,350$. The March, 1934, importations were obtained from the Unitod States.
