GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CAMADA, APRIL, 1934.

The Canadian production of gypsum in April reached a total of 25,483 tons as compared with 4,888 tons in the preceding month and 4,241 tons in April, 1933, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first four months of 1934 the Canadian output totalled 36,983 tons or 172.8 per cent above the tonnage produced in the corresponding period of 1933.

No crude gypsum was exported from Canada in April. Plaster of Paris exports in April amounted to 19 tons, in March 32 tons were exported. In April, Canada imported 51 tons of ground gypsum worth \$1,910; during the previous month 8 tons valued at \$188 were imported. Plaster of Paris imports amounted to 43 tons appraised at \$1,029 as against 56 tons at \$2,176 in March.
