## GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA, MAY, 1934.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that the output of gypsum in Canada during May reached a total of 53,353 tons as compared with 25,483 tons in the preceding month and 33,400 tons in May, 1933. Gypsum production during the five months ending May totalled 90,336 tons, an advance of 92.4 per cent above the output in the corresponding period of 1933.

Crude gypsum exports amounted to 19,811 tons in May. No crude gypsum was exported during the preceding three months. Ten tons of plaster of Paris were shipped from Canada in May as compared with 19 tons in the previous month.

Canada imported 5 tons of ground gypsum valued at \$159; during April 51 tons worth \$1,910 were imported. Importations of plaster of Paris rose to 49 tons at \$1,345 from the April total of 43 tons worth \$1,029.
