GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JANUARY, 1935.

The Canadian output of gypsum in January was recorded at 3,500 tons; in December, 27,686 tons were produced while in January, 1934, the total was 3,303 tons, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Crude gypsum exports during January amounted to 22,150 tons as compared with 55,742 tons in December and 25,851 tons in January, 1934. Plaster of Paris exportations declined to 28 tons from the preceding month's total of 73 tons and the January, 1934, exports of 180 tons.

Imports of plaster of Paris into Canada in January rose to 142 tons worth \$2,656 from the December importations of 72 tons at \$1,409. Receipts of ground gypsum amounted to 3 tons with a valuation of \$141; in December, 1 ton worth \$68 was brought into Canada.
