GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - FEBRUARY, 1935.

Gypsum production in Canada during February amounted to 3,289 tons as against 3,500 tons in January and 3,309 tons in February, 1934, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During tha first two months of 1935 Canada produced 6,789 tons of gypsum; in the corresponding period of 1934 the production totalled 6,612 tons.

No crude gypsum was exported from Canada in February; during the preceding month 22,150 tons were exported to the United States. Fifty-six tons of plaster of Paris were exported from Canada during February as compared with 28 tons in January.

Four tons of crude gypsum worth \$51 were imported into Canada in February. Receipts of ground gypsum in February were negligible, amounting to only one ton valued at \$72. Plaster of Paris importations declined to 74 tons at \$1,425 from the January total of 142 tons worth \$2,656.
