GYPSUM PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JUNE, 1935.

The Canadian production of gypsum in June rose to 75,525 tons from the May total of 58,312 tons and the June, 1934, output of 67,995 tons, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Crude gypsum exports from Canada in June were recorded at 50,477 tons; in the preceding month 18,722 tons were exported. Exports of crude gypsum during the first six months of 1935 totalled 91,357 tons worth \$104,294. Plaster of Paris exportations in June amounted to 89 tons as against 52 tons in May. Shipments of plaster of Paris from Canada during the period January to June, 1935, totalled 339 tons with a valuation of \$13,468.

Twenty-one tons of ground gypsum valued at \$468 were imported into Canada in June; during May, 46 tons at \$1,001 were imported. Receipts of plaster of Paris declined to 90 tons worth \$1,718 from the May total of 209 tons at \$3,002.
